All plenary and invited speakers will be expected to submit a paper for publication in a special issue of Plasma Physics and Controlled Fusion following the conference.

Please note:

Members of the Programme Committee or EPS Plasma Physics Division Board cannot be nominated for plenary or invited talks (but are welcome to submit contributed papers).

A speaker cannot be re-nominated if they were invited in either of the past two conferences.

Self-nominations for plenary and invited talks are accepted, please make sure this is clear in your submission.
